OUR STORY AND PURPOSE

Since 2020 and throughout 2021, the COVID-19 Counseling and Support Services (Hotline) provided many New Mexicans and their families impacted by the pandemic much needed support. The counseling services were delivered in collaboration with the New Mexico Human Services Department (HSD), Behavioral Health Services Division (BHSD), the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and a host of service providers.

As of January 7, 2022, over 86,236 New Mexican's were helped. Due to the expiration of funding from FEMA, effective January 29, 2022, there has been a transition to phase out the services provided through this hotline. During the transition, people may continue to call 505-954-1057 (hotline).

The purpose of this Resource Guide is to support New Mexico behavioral health providers and advocates with a comprehensive listing of resources that can support New Mexicans and their families. The COVID-19 Pandemic highlighted the need for a comprehensive listing these services. This Resource Directory is a compilation of over 400 entities and organizations located throughout the state: tribal, county, state, national, and non-government.
